OFFICIAL RULES

Sponsored by Kraddick Fund for Kids d/b/a Kidd's Kids and YEA Media Group, its subsidiaries, and affiliated companies (herein "Sponsor").

OPEN ONLY TO INDIVIDUALS WHO ARE LEGAL RESIDENTS OF, AND CURRENTLY RESIDING WITHIN THE FORTY-EIGHT (48) CONTIGUOUS UNITED STATES AND THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA ("D.C.") (EXCLUDING NEW YORK AND FLORIDA), WHO ARE AT LEAST NINETEEN (19) YEARS OF AGE OR OLDER AT THE TIME OF ENTRY. VOID OUTSIDE OF THE FORTY-EIGHT (48) UNITED STATES/D.C. AND WHEREVER PROHIBITED BY LAW. THIS SWEEPSTAKES IS GOVERNED BY UNITED STATES LAW. DO NOT ENTER IF YOU ARE NOT A RESIDENT OF AND LOCATED IN THE FORTY-EIGHT (48) CONTIGUOUS UNITED STATES OR D.C. AT TIME OF ENTRY.

- 1. Sweepstakes Period:** Kidd's Kids "Harry Styles Concert" Sweepstakes ("Sweepstakes") begins on August 16, 2026 at 9:00pm CDT and ends on August 26, 2026 at 11:59pm CDT ("Sweepstakes Period"). Sponsor is the official timekeeper for the Sweepstakes.
- 2. Eligibility:** The Sweepstakes is open only to legal residents of 48 contiguous United States and D.C. (except New York and Florida) who are currently residing therein, and who are at least nineteen (19) years of age or older at the time of entry. Employees, officers and directors of Kidd's Kids, YEA Media Group, their respective parent companies, affiliates, subsidiaries, distributors, suppliers and advertising and promotion agencies associated with the Sweepstakes, and members of the immediate families (defined as including spouse, biological, adoptive and step-parents, grandparents, siblings, children and grandchildren, and each of their respective spouses, regardless of where they reside) or households (whether related or not) of any of the above are NOT eligible to participate in the Sweepstakes. - 3. How to Enter:** There are two (2) ways to enter. During the Sweepstakes Period, go to www.KiddsKids.org and click on the "Harry Styles Concert Sweepstakes" button to purchase an entry; for every \$20 purchase the participant will receive 20 entries, for every \$40 purchase the participant will receive 50 entries, and for every \$100 purchase the participant will receive 150 entries. To receive one (1) entry without making a purchase, mail a card with your full name, address, city, state, ZIP code, email address, and phone number before August 26, 2026 at 11:59pm CDT. **Limit one (1) free entry per person, per Sweepstakes period.** No robotic, programmed, script, macro, or other automated entries (collectively "Automated Entries"). **Address mailed entry to "Harry Styles Concert**

Sponsor and respective directors, officers, agents, and employees are not responsible for lost, late, misdirected, or incomplete entries. Incomplete entries will not be acknowledged and will not be included in the Sweepstakes drawing. All entries submitted become property of Sponsor. Submission of an entry is subject to, and all entrants must comply with, all policies, terms and conditions set forth in these Official Rules. Proof of submission does not constitute proof of receipt. Only the person associated with the entry may be entitled to a prize. In the event of a dispute as to who entered, the name of the “authorized account holder” associated with the email account used for entry will be deemed to be the entrant as long as such person is eligible and in compliance with these Official Rules. The authorized account holder of the email address is defined as the natural person who is assigned to the email address by an Internet access provider, online service provider, or other organization that is responsible for assigning email addresses or the domain associated with the submitted email address. Entries must be completed by 11:59 pm CST on August 26, 2026 to count toward entry into the Sweepstakes drawing. Any entry that does not comply with these requirements, in the sole opinion of the Sponsor, may be disqualified.

- 4. How to Win:** To be eligible for the First Prize Sweepstakes drawing, an eligible entry must be received during the Sweepstakes Period. Odds of winning the Sweepstakes prize will depend on the total number of eligible entries received during the period. **One (1) name will be drawn at random on or around August 27, 2026.**

Sweepstakes Prize: To be eligible for the sweepstakes drawing, an eligible entry must be received during the entire Sweepstakes Period. Odds of winning the Sweepstakes prize will depend on the total number of eligible entries received. Kidd’s Kids will randomly select one (1) winner from all eligible entries and attempt to contact them via **EMAIL** and/or **PHONE** on or after August 27, 2026. The winner will have 72 hours to confirm their eligibility and redeem the prize. If a designated winner is not available or not eligible, the Sponsor reserves the right to determine an alternate winner through another random drawing until a winner is confirmed.

- 5. Prizes and Approximate Retail Value (“ARV”):** There will be one (1) prize given to one (1) winner:
- a. **Grand Prize (Total ARV: \$3,800):**
 - i. Two (2) tickets to see Harry Styles in concert on Saturday, September 19, 2026 at Madison Square Garden in New York, NY (ARV: \$2,000)
 - ii. Roundtrip domestic air travel on Southwest Airlines for use by one (1) winner and winner’s one (1) guest to New York, NY (subject to Air Travel Restrictions set forth below). (ARV: \$800)
 - iii. \$1,000 cash that can be used for accommodations

The cash prize will be distributed via an ACH transaction. The ARV of the prizes are subject to change. Any difference between the stated ARV and the actual prize value will not be awarded. **If the winner does not live near an airport operated by Southwest Airlines, an alternate travel option will NOT be given and the cash value will NOT be given.
